After Jesus had washed his disciples' feet, he said to them, "Do you understand what I have done to you? You call me Master and Lord, and rightly; so I am. To do Christian Service as a "requirement for Confirmation" can easily be misunderstood to mean one can "earn" Confirmation. No one can "earn" a gift. The whole notion of Christian service is that it is at the heart of being a disciple of Jesus, as the above passages express. Christian service is first and foremost a **response** of gratitude to God because He has shown us incredible generosity and, as a result, we wish to respond generously by serving others. Let these requirements be an opportunity to develop a "good habit", a virtue, of service so that we continue to show our gratitude to God in real and affirming ways, giving generously and consistently to others.

NOTE: The minimum summer service hours are 15 hours and ideally should be done with ONE organization or one type of service that falls under one or more of these *Corporal* & *Spiritual* Works of Mercy:

Corporal Works of Mercy feeding the hungry sheltering the homeless clothing the naked visiting the sick (and imprisoned) burying the dead Spiritual Works of Mercy teaching the Catholic faith counseling consoling comforting forgiving bearing wrongs patiently
