NOTICE FOR ALL VOLUNTEERS

DEFINITION & GUIDELINES

THE DIOCESAN MASTER INSURANCE PROGRAM
DEFINES A VOLUNTEER AS A PERSON
WHO RENDERS TIME OR SERVICES
DIRECTLY TO THE NAMED INSURED WITHOUT ANY TYPE OF
REMUNERATION OR FINANCIAL COMPENSATION.

GENERAL LIABILITY

- There *IS COVERAGE* for Volunteers for negligent actions *covered under the policy*, which result in injury to another person or persons.
- There is *NO COVERAGE* for criminal or intentional acts of Volunteers.
- ► There is NO WORKERS' COMPENSATION or DISABILITY INSURANCE COVERAGE for injured Volunteers.

AUTOMOBILE

- There is *NO COVERAGE* for vehicles personally owned or leased by Volunteers.
- There is *NO COVERAGE* for damage sustained to a volunteer's vehicle, or for liability incurred, due to an automobile accident while acting as a Volunteer.
- Volunteers using their own vehicle *must* provide proof of automobile liability insurance to the insured entity.

DIRECTORS & OFFICERS LIABILITY

There *IS COVERAGE* for Volunteers while acting as an officer, director, board member, or trustee in the event that claims are brought against them because of wrongful acts, allegedly wrongful acts, or omissions made while acting in such a capacity.
