The video presentation we are about to see was produced by the Knights of Columbus and illustrates the gravity of our duty as men of Christ and offers us an invitation to renew Christ based masculinity.



The life of a believer is a Spiritual Battle. We men have multiple spiritual weapons in the fight against Satan, and the stakes are high. Men have experience with abuse and addiction and finding forgiveness and freedom in Christ. Let us learn from these redeemed souls.

What does it mean to be a Christian man? What is your role in getting your Spouse, Children and Loved Ones to Heaven? Why is fatherhood, fully understood, so crucial for every man? How do we understand and develop our perception of God?

Why are you here? To know God. To love God. To serve God. As a man, you are called to share the faith. You are called to live the faith. It's time to discover your role as a Catholic man in today's world.

One day when we die, we are hoping to hear those words, "Well done my Good and Faithful servant. Enter the Kingdom of Heaven". How do we perfect the life that has been given to us so that we may hear that message when our life is over?



The episode discusses how the challenge of living as a man of God, is made very difficult because Satan wants us to fail. He is looking to call you a Hypocrite. God knows our Sins, but He calls us by our Name. The Devil knows our Name, but he calls us by our Sins.

However, we "were made for this fight" by God. Why might a man feel unqualified or unprepared to fully embrace an authentically masculine role? In life, have you ever experienced a moment where you thought, "I'm in over my head here"? How did you get from there to "I've got this"?

What tools are available to help men better understand and grow in their faith and fulfill their roles as men, Catholics, husbands, fathers and leaders?

<u>Holy Scripture</u>

Romans 8:5-11 – The Flesh and the Spirit

For those who live according to the flesh are concerned with the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the spirit with the things of the spirit.

The concern of the flesh is death, but the concern of the spirit is life and peace. For the concern of the flesh is hostility toward God; it does not submit to the law of God, nor can it; and those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

But you are not in the flesh; on the contrary, you are in the spirit, if only the Spirit of God dwells in you. Whoever does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him. But if Christ is in you, although the body is dead because of sin, the spirit is alive because of righteousness.

If the Spirit of the one who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, the one who raised Christ from the dead will give life to your mortal bodies also, through his Spirit that dwells in you.

Romans 12:1-2 – Sacrifice of Body and Mind

I urge you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God, your spiritual worship.

Do not conform yourselves to this age but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and pleasing and perfect.

CCC 1776 – Moral Conscience

Deep within his conscience, man discovers a law which he has not laid upon himself but which he must obey. Its voice, ever calling him to love and to do what is good and to avoid evil, sounds in his heart at the right moment. . . . For man has in his heart a law inscribed by God. . . . Call to Battle – Find additional time for prayer or reading of Scripture this month and ask Jesus and the Holy Spirit to form your mind and heart in the light of the Gospel. Exercising self-control over the body builds self-control over the will, and therefore resistance to bad habits and temptations. Use the Power of the Holy Eucharist, the Power of the Sacraments and the Power of Prayer for the good of God.

Read about the life of one of the saints who exemplified manliness: St. Joseph, St. George, St. Thomas More and St. John Paul II come to mind, but there are many others. Identify how this saint exhibited manliness and write down specific, concrete resolutions on how you can emulate him.

Imitate Christ! Jesus Christ shows us the fullness of what it means to be a man. Pick one of the Gospels and read a short portion, at least a few verses, each day. Meditate on these passages to discover the ways in which Christ exhibits true manliness and better understand how to be a man of God.

Questions to Focus on:

1. What is THE Duty of a Catholic Man? What does Christ teach us about Spiritual Warfare?



2. Is there someone you have looked up to that presents authentic masculinity? Why?

3. What's your role in getting Spouse, Children and Loved Ones to Heaven?

The Memorare


