

May God bless us with His Wisdom and His Work and the wherewithal to complete the mission. Amen




Luke 10:30-37

The Good Samaritan.

A scholar of the law wished to justify himself and said to Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?"

Jesus replied, "A man fell victim to robbers as he went down from Jerusalem to Jericho. They stripped and beat him and went off leaving him half-dead. A priest happened to be going down that road, but when he saw him, he passed by on the opposite side.



Likewise a Levite came to the place, and when he saw him, he passed by on the opposite side. But a Samaritan traveler who came upon him was moved with compassion at the sight.


He approached the victim, poured oil and wine over his wounds and bandaged them. Then he lifted him up on his own animal, took him to an inn and cared for him.



How to Unleash the Good Man Inside

2447 The works of mercy are charitable

actions by which we come to the aid of our neighbor in his spiritual and bodily needs. Instructing, advising, consoling, comforting are spiritual works of mercy, as are forgiving and bearing wrongs patiently. The corporal works of mercy consist especially in feeding the hungry, sheltering the homeless, clothing the naked, visiting the sick and imprisoned, and burying the dead. Among all these, giving alms to the poor is one of the chief witnesses to fraternal charity: it is also a work of justice pleasing to God.





The Works of Mercy and Charity:

- 1. To feed the Hungry.
- 2. To give drink to the Thirsty.
- 3. To clothe the Naked.
- 4. To Shelter the Homeless.
- 5. To visit the Sick.
- 6. To visit the Imprisoned.
- 7. To bury the Dead.

Ask, and you will receive. Seek, and you will find. Knock and the door will be opened.


