



Two Important Questions



- 6. To learn that there are persons that love them dearly, but simply do not know how to express or show their feelings.
- 7. To learn that two people can look at the same thing and see it totally differently.
- 8. To learn that it is not always enough that they be forgiven by others, but that they have to forgive themselves.

"Thank you for your time." I said Humbly. "Is there anything else you would like your children to know?"

9. To learn that I am here...ALWAYS.

People will forget what you said, people will forget what you did, but people will never forget how you made them feel.


