

Holy Land, Holy Spaces The Rest of the Story

As you discipline your mind towards healthy thoughts and ideas, your body soon follows. You gain a fit, strong, and vigorous physique. As you bend your attention, thinking, and awareness towards God, your heart follows. Your soul becomes liberated, light and unbound.



This past February a group of over 50 people primarily from St. Hilary went to Israel to tour the Holy Land and experience the Gospel of St. Luke in the land and specific places where the events in it occurred.

Regarding St. Luke: he ties in the biblical history of God's dealings with humanity, specifically showing how God's promises to Israel have been fulfilled in Jesus. Luke binds and connects how the salvation promised to Israel and accomplished by Jesus has been extended, broadened, and offered to the Gentiles.

It is essential to note that Luke's story of Jesus and the church is dominated by a historical perspective with emphasis on salvation history. The story as conveyed by St. Luke is set in, tied to and documented as part of Human History. These are Real events as seen and experienced by eyewitnesses.¹

Thus upon arriving in Israel and starting in Nazareth, it soon became evident that something special was happening. The realization that Jesus Christ was not just some intellectual ascent, but a real human being with physical evidence of his existence began to seep into one's consciousness.

¹ Also important: Luke shows that the preaching and teaching of the representatives of the early church are grounded in the preaching and teaching of Jesus. Luke documents His historical ministry prepared His specially chosen followers and commissioned them to be witnesses to His resurrection and to all else that He did. This continuity between the historical ministry of Jesus and the ministry of the apostles is Luke's way of guaranteeing the fidelity of the Church's teaching to the teaching of Jesus.

One's awareness began to understand that Jesus was real, actual, factual, and tangible. He was made of flesh, blood, muscle, bone, sinew, and hair. Jesus walked the stone pavements, paths and roads. He breathed the air, drank the water and sat on the ground. Jesus became extant. Jesus became present.

Let us pay close attention to the Scripture and our presentation. May God bless us with His Wisdom, His Work and the wherewithal to complete the specific mission given to each one of us. Amen. And AMEN.

Luke 1:26-38 Announcement of the Birth of Jesus

In the sixth month, the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a town of Galilee called Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man named Joseph, of the house of David, and the virgin's name was Mary.

Catechism *Prayer Before Action* **2600**

The Gospel according to St. Luke emphasizes the action of the Holy Spirit and the meaning of prayer in Christ's ministry. Jesus prays before the decisive moments of his mission: before his Father's witness to him during his baptism and Transfiguration, and before his own fulfillment of the Father's plan of love by his Passion.

He also prays before the decisive moments involving the mission of his apostles: at his election and call of the Twelve, before Peter's confession of him as "the Christ of God," and again that the faith of the chief of the Apostles may not fail when tempted.

Jesus' prayer before the events of salvation that the Father has asked him to fulfill is a humble and trusting commitment of his human will to the loving will of the Father.


Come dwell in my heart.
