Blessed Mother in Fatima The 100th Anniversary

In the spring of 1916, there were three visitations by the Guardian Angel of Portugal to 3 children who were tending their flock of sheep. On the initial visit, his first words to them were,

"Do not be afraid. I am the angel of peace. Pray with me."

He visited with them 2 more times. Almost eight months passed since the last apparition of the Angel when on May 13, 1917 the children were visited by the Blessed Mother as they were tending their flock in a pasture.



On that day, they prayed a rosary after having noon lunch. Shortly after finishing, they were startled by what they described as "lightning in a clear sky." Thinking that a storm might be approaching they began to go down the slope driving the sheep towards the road.

About half way down, another flash of lightning, after a few steps, they saw on a small oak, a lady dressed in white, shining brighter than the sun, spreading rays of clear intense light.

They stopped, astounded by the Apparition. They were so near that they were in the light that encircled her, which she radiated out 4-5 feet. Mary's first words to them were, "Please don't be afraid of me, I'm not going to harm you. I come from heaven."

Today May 13, is exactly 100 years ago that the Blessed Mother began the first of six visits with these three special children of Portugal. David Eich is going to walk us through that special series of visits of the Blessed Virgin to Portugal.

How Aware am I of God's Presence


Modern Exercise – Twice Daily

Amen. And AMEN.




