Black Abortions in America are in excess of 40% of the total killing of infants. Yet, American Blacks are only 12% of the population. The scourge of Abortion in America is an apparent Genocide of the Black Community, which was Margaret Sanger's goal was when she founded Planned Parenthood.

First, let us consider how the master of deceit is manifested in our culture, in nations worldwide and in our daily lives. We see it in the disintegration of the Family and massacre of Innocents through Abortion, the sacrament of the Progressive Movement.

Add in the fact that 72% Black babies are born to single mothers, there is a war on Black America that can be directly traced back to Lyndon Johnson and the "War on Poverty" legislation of 1964. A more appropriate name should be the "War on the American Family".


Consider what our family brokenness has done to society:

- 3 in 10 children grow up in broken homes.
- In the African-American community, it is far worse: 72% of black children grow up with one parent.
- More than half of all American babies are conceived out of wedlock
- Of those conceived out of wedlock, 4 in 10 are aborted. And so, the cycle of violence begins.

Of the survivors of abortion, half the children born out of wedlock end up in poverty.

Children from broken homes account for:

- 63% of teen suicides.
- 71% of teen pregnancies.
- 90% of homeless and runaways.
- 71% of high school dropouts.
- 75% of all drug users.
- 85% of behavioral disorders.
- 70% of those in juvenile detention.
- 57% of all prison inmates.



Margaret Sanger is as evil as Adolph Hitler is, but in a much more subtle and sadistic way.

Armed with the Truth about an Evil in our midst today, are we Man enough to speak up and take action? Let us pay close attention to the Scriptures, Catechism and our presentation. May God bless us with His Wisdom, His Work and the wherewithal to complete the mission. Amen

God Made Each Man With a Special Plan

2270

Human life must be respected and protected absolutely from the moment of conception. From the first moment of his existence, a human being must be recognized as having the rights of a person—among which is the inviolable right of every innocent being to life.

2271

Since the first century the Church has affirmed the moral evil of every procured abortion.

2273

The inalienable right to life of every innocent human individual is an essential element of a civil society and its legislation.

2274

Since the fetus must be treated from conception as a person, the embryo must be defended in its integrity, cared for, and healed, as far as possible, like any other human being.


