

The Kerygma – The Good News to Proclaim (MFC)

1. Love Creates

- We are created in God's image and likeness: made in love, by love, to share love

2. Sin Breaks

- Sin severs the relationships we share and distorts truth leaving us restlessly wandering in illusion and fractured...humanity needs saved!

3. Jesus Redeems and Renews

- Jesus Christ redeems mankind and calls us back to a loving relationship with him and the Father through the Holy Spirit – He lovingly pulls us from the muck of sin!

4. We Change our Ways

- We repent (deep conversion which leads us to imitate Christ) and receive the Holy Spirit (We say yes to God)

5. We Share our Story

- Renewed as Christians, we are called to NEW LIFE with God and relationship with Jesus Christ...and as missionary disciples, we must passionately and joyfully share this news with those longing to hear!

Evangelizing as Missionary Disciples (recommendations from the CLE office of Missionary Discipleship)

1. PRAY to be filled with the Holy Spirit
2. Lead with Joy (understand the Good News that gives you sustaining joy)
3. Begin with listening to the other
4. Keep your story simple and personal (share the gospel impact in your own life)!
5. Focus on our human desires and needs at first and share how Christ fulfills these in your life
6. Be lovingly hospitable and INVITE OTHERS IN!
7. GO OUT BEYOND YOUR COMFORT ZONES and TRUST
8. Follow up with love!
9. Don't worry about the harvest just plant the seeds (use your gifts to build the Kingdom)
10. PRAY for those you interact with
