



Catechism

CCC 2426 – Career is the First Part of your Life; Your Calling is your Whole Life
The development of economic activity and growth in production are meant to provide for
the needs of human beings. Economic life is not meant solely to multiply goods produced
and increase profit or power; it is ordered first of all to the service of persons, of the whole
man, and of the entire human community. Economic activity, conducted according to its
own proper methods, is to be exercised within the limits of the moral order, in keeping with
social justice so as to correspond to God's plan for man.

CCC 2426 – Accomplish the Plan, Finish the Mission

Death is the end of man's earthly pilgrimage, of the time of grace and mercy which God offers him so as to work out his earthly life in keeping with the divine plan, and to decide his ultimate destiny. When "the single course of our earthly life" is completed, we shall not return to other earthly lives: "It is appointed for men to die once."

There is no "reincarnation" after death.



Foregiveness is a Gift that we give first to ourselves then to the other.


Jesus wants us to make choices that reflect His presence in our hearts.
